



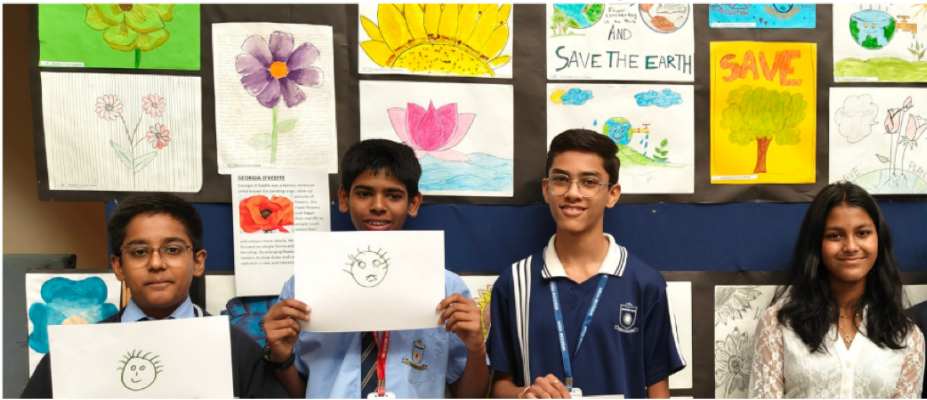

# SAFEENA HUSAIN: EDUCATING INDIA ONE GIRL AT A TIME

Safeena Husain knows what it feels like to be pulled out of school. As a child, unforeseen circumstances forced her to stop attending classes, and she watched her confidence quietly diminish as her peers moved forward without her. That wound, rather than bringing her down, became her motivation to do something greater in life.

In 2007, she founded “Educate Girls” in 50 villages of Rajasthan, not for fandom, but with a simple, stubborn belief that no girl should be left behind. She knocked on doors, sat with families, and worked alongside government schools to provide young girls with education they deserve.

The results speak for themselves. Through a network of over 23,000 community volunteers, Educate Girls has helped enroll more than 2 million out-of-school girls and improved learning outcomes for 2.4 million children. The organization today has a reach of over 25,000 villages across Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, and Uttar Pradesh.

Along the way, Husain also changed how social impact is financed. Educate Girls launched the world's first Development Impact Bond in education: a model that far exceeded its targets when completed in 2018.

The recognition followed naturally. She received the WISE Prize for Education in 2023, led Educate Girls to the Ramon Magsaysay Award in 2025, and was named among TIME's Women of the Year in 2026.

But she remains focused on what lies ahead. She says, "We women will not be equal unless that last girl has equality", and she intends to reach 10 million learners by 2035 to prove to the world a single educated girl can rewrite the destiny of generations.
